**NECESSARY SPECIAL QUALIFICATION:**

Possession of a valid Guam Teaching Certificate.

**NOTE:**

Documents to verify training and experience that are required, must be submitted with the employment application form before evaluation can be made. Only training and experience supported by satisfactory documents will be credited.

**PROHIBITION: Pursuant to P.L. No. 28-98,** “ No person convicted of a sex offense under the provisions of Chapter 25 of Title 9 GCA, or an offense as defined in Article 2 of Chapter 28, Title 9 GCA in Guam, or an offense in any jurisdiction which includes, at a minimum, all of the elements of said offenses, or who is listed on the Sex Offender Registry shall work in any agency or instrumentality of the Government of Guam.”

**WORK ELIGIBILITY INFORMATION:**

Public Law 99-603 (8 USC Section 1324A) requires the Government of Guam to verify the identity and work eligibility of all newly hired employees. All employees shall be required to provide proof of identity and work eligibility to work in the United States. The Government of Guam is required to comply with this law on a non-discriminatory basis.

If you are hired to fill a position with the Guam Department of Education, Government of Guam, you will be required to present valid documents that will establish your identity and work eligibility in the United States and its territories. Any one or combinations of the following documents may be required.

- Certified Birth Certificate
- U.S. Passport
- Naturalization Card
- “Green Card” (For Immigrants)
- Government of Guam I.D. Card
- Original Social Security Card (not laminated)
- Other proof of work eligibility

**PRE-EMPLOYMENT TUBERCULOSIS TESTING:**

All applicants accepting employment with the Guam Department of Education, Government of Guam are required to submit a Tuberculosis work clearance. Upon employment and annually thereafter, employee must submit a Tuberculosis work clearance as a initial of continued employment. Expenses for the Tuberculosis Testing must be paid for by the applicant.

**PRE-EMPLOYMENT PHYSICAL/MEDICAL EXAMINATION:**

All applicants accepting employment with the Guam Department of Education must take and pass an entry physical/medical examination as a condition of continued employment. Expenses for the physical/medical examination must be paid by the applicant.

**DRUG SCREENING:**

Pursuant to Executive Order No. 95-29 and the Guam Department of Education Personnel Rules and Regulations, all applicants selected for appointment in the Guam Department of Education, Government of Guam, will be required to undergo Drug Testing as a initial of employment. Expenses for the drug test must be paid for by the selected applicant.

**POLICE & COURT CLEARANCES:**

Pursuant to Executive Order No. 2005-34 and Public Law No. 28-24, all applicants **selected** for employment are required to submit a Police and Superior Court of Guam Clearances before commencement of employment.

**APPLICATION DEADLINE:**

Applications shall be submitted to the Guam Department of Education, Personnel Services Division from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except holidays. Completed applications with supporting documents must be received by the deadline.

**APPLICATION SUBMISSION:**

Interested applicants must submit a **GDOE "Application for Employment"** form to the **GUAM DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, PERSONNEL SERVICES DIVISION**.
